



A world-class transit system

An integrated network of buses, rapid transit and ferries, the Vancouver Regional Transit System is a highly efficient "people mover." Its service area is the largest of any Canadian transit system, encompassing approximately 1,500 square kilometres. The system carried over 105 million passengers during the past year... utilizing over 800 buses and trolley coaches, 114 rail

cars and two harbour ferries. The system is a partnership of local and provincial government agencies. BCTransit, a provincial crown corporation, shares the cost of operating the system with the Vancouver Regional Transit Commission.

The Transit Commission, consisting of locally elected mayors and aldermen, is also responsible for the setting of fares, determining the level of service including new routes and changes to existing routes, and setting of rates for gasoline tax, hydro levy and property tax in order to raise the local share of transit operating

The Vancouver Regional Transit System services are operated by BCTransit, West Vancouver Municipal Transportation Department (Blue Buses) and B.C. Rapid Transit Company Ltd. (SkyTrain).

SkyTrain – the system's newest link

An advanced light rapid transit system, SkyTrain is an integral part of the Vancouver Regional Transit System. Offering direct, efficient service from New Westminster to downtown Vancouver, it links with many buses at stations along its 22-kilometre route...and with SeaBus on the Vancouver waterfront.

Frequent rapid transit service means you'll always make a good connection when transferring from bus or SeaBus to SkyTrain. In the reverse order, please remember that SkyTrain runs much more frequently than either bus or SeaBus. To make your best connection, consult your local bus timetable...in combination with the SkyTrain information below.

SeaBus — an advanced commuter ferry

A vital link in the Vancouver Regional Transit System, SeaBus provides regular ferry service between Waterfront Station in downtown Vancouver and Lonsdale Quay in North Vancouver. At Lonsdale Quay, bus connections are available to most parts of North Vancouver. At Waterfront Station, SeaBus connects with both SkyTrain and a number of Vancouver bus routes.

Fares

The Vancouver Regional Transit System is divided into three fare zones, as shown on the Fare Zone Map (see over). During rush hours, the amount you pay depends upon the number of zone boundaries you cross. In off-peak times, you can travel one-way anywhere in the region for the single fare. Fares are the same whether you travel by bus, SkyTrain or SeaBus.

Rush-hour fares apply before 9:30 a.m. and between 3 p.m. and 6:30 p.m., Monday to Friday. Off-peak fares apply between 9:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. and after 6:30 p.m., Monday to Friday and all day Saturday, Sunday and holidays.

fares must be paid in exact change; no bills, please. BC Transit regrets that it cannot accept foreign currency, including U.S. bills.

Transferring. Single tickets purchased from self-serve machines at SkyTrain stations and SeaBus terminals serve as both fare receipt and transfer. When paying cash on a bus, remember that you require a transfer i making a transit connection on the way to your destination. Fare Receipt/Transfers are issued only at the time a fare is paid. They are valid for 90 minutes travel

in one direction only. Proof of payment. When transferring from one transit vehicle to another, crossing a zone boundary during rush hours and at all times when in a "Fare Paid Zone. valid proof of payment must be carried. "Fare Paid Zones" include all buses, SkyTrain cars, stations and platforms, SeaBus vessels and terminals. "Proof of payment" includes a valid fare receipt/transfer, Day-Pass, FareCard or validated FareSaver or Concession ticket. Persons without valid proof of payment will be

Concession fares apply to senior citizens, students to Grade 12 with valid GoCards and children ages 5 to 13. Children under 5 may travel free when accompanied by an adult.

Tickets and passes

Tickets and passes are good for travel on all Vancouver Regional Transit System routes, including SkyTrain

Monthly FareCards. If you ride a lot, you'll save with a FareCard – and it's transferable, so you can lend it to others when you're not using it. There are four types of FareCards, One Zone, Two Zone (Urban or Suburban), Three Zone or Concession.

FareSaver Tickets. These handy, economical tickets are sold in books of 10, at a 10% discount over single fares. FareSavers have no expiry date, so you can purchase them in advance and use them at your convenience. Adult FareSavers are available in One Zone, Two Zone or Three Zones.

Concession Tickets. Concession Tickets for seniors, children and Greater Vancouver area Secondary school students with valid GoCards, are good for one-zone rush-hour or multi-zone off-peak travel. They are sold in books of 10 and can be purchased in advance for use at your convenience.

Please note: When starting your trip by SkyTrain or SeaBus, tickets must be stamped by a ticket machine to be validated and then become a fare receipt/transfer.

Single Tickets. If you start your trip on SkyTrain or SeaBus, single tickets are available from self-serve ticket machines located at each station and terminal. These machines accept coins (5¢, 10¢, 25¢, \$1), \$1 and \$2 bills and can return change. Single tickets serve as fare receipt/transfer.

Scratch-and-Ride DayPasses. These hand DayPasses are good for one day's unlimited travel after 9:30 a.m. weekdays and all day Saturday, Sunday and holidays. Full-fare Adult and reduced-fare Concession DayPasses may be purchased in advance then validated on the day used. Simply use a coin to scratch off the appropriate grey panel to uncover the month and date

Ticket Machine DayPasses. Machine-purchased Day-Passes are available from ticket machines at SkyTrain and SeaBus and are good for one days unlimited travel on the day purchased. Please note: Ticket machines do not sell DayPasses before 9:30 a.m.

AddFares. One and Two Zone FareCards, FareSaver Tickets and One Zone Concession Ticlets can be upgraded to cross additional zone boundaries during rush hours. AddFares can be purchased from ticket machines at SkyTrain or SeaBus and by depositing the

additional amount in the fare box on buses.

FareDealers. Tickets and passes are sold at the 7-Eleven, Canadian Imperial Bank of Comnerce (Fare-Cards only), VTC/CBO, Safeway, credit unon, convenience store, smoke shop or drug store displaying the "FareDealer" symbol.

Transit timetables

Detailed transit schedules are available from a number of convenient outlets, including public libraries, city and municipal halls, information centres, community centres, chambers of commerce, the Vancouver Travel InfoCentre, BC Transit Lost Property, BC Transit Administration Offices, SeaBus terminals, and most Fare-Dealer outlets.

Special transit services

Express bus service is offered to many special events, including home games of the B.C. Lions at B.C. Place Stadium and the Vancouver Canucks at Pacific Coliseum and during the City's annual Fair, the PNE. "Around the Park" bus service in Stanley Park is provided on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays from the end of April to the last Saturday in October (weather permitting). Additional service to Grouse Mountain is offered on the #236 route from Lonsdale Quay in North Vancouver between May 20 and October 9

Airport service

BC Transit provides service to the Vancouver International Airport on the #100 route. In addition, Perimeter Transportation provides express airport service from downtown Vancouver. Call 273-0071 for information.
